



# Welcome to Woodpeckers Class

## Routines and Equipment

**PE/Swimming** : children should come dressed for PE on Monday. Please ensure your child has the correct PE uniform.

**Homework**: Homework will be given out on a Friday and handed in the following Friday. Children are expected to finish all homework given and lunchtime will be used to complete homework if this has not been done at home. All homework will be on the weekly blog for ease of reference.

**Reading challenge**: Weekly reads will be counted every Friday and will run from Friday to Friday so please make sure these are recorded in the planner (5 reads per week minimum).

**Equipment**: Reading book, planner need to be in school every day. Please do not bring a pencil case into school, as the children are provided with all the resources they will need.

**Uniform**: Please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform and school shoes. Uniform plays a key role in promoting a school's ethos, providing a sense of belonging and identity and creating a learning environment.
